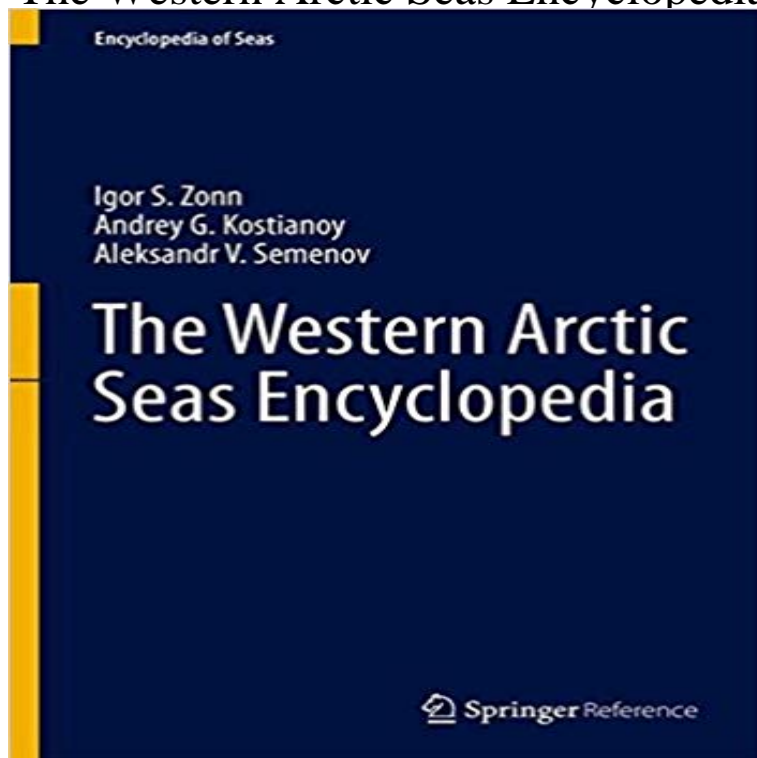


The Western Arctic Seas Encyclopedia (Encyclopedia of Seas)
